LOCAL RULES

1. OUT OF BOUNDS (RULE 18.2)

- Beyond any fence bounding the course.
- In or over any ditch bounding the plantations.
- The car park and clubhouse surrounds as defined by white posts.

2. PROTECTION OF YOUNG TREES

If a young tree identified by a stake or band interferes with a player's stance or area of intend swing, the ball may be lifted without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rules 16.1a/b (immovable obstruction).

3. GROUND UNDER REPAIR

Play is prohibited within G.U.R. demarcated areas, this includes flower beds. The player must take relief under Rule 16.1a/b.

4. SPRINKLER HEADS

Sprinkler heads shall be classed as immovable obstructions. (see Rule 16.1a/b/d)

5. ROADS AND PATHS

The road adjacent to the 18th fairway is an integral part of the course and the ball must be played as it lies or declared unplayable (Rule 19.1/2). All other artificially surfaced roads and paths are immovable obstructions. (Rule 16.1a/b)

6. RAILWAY TRACKS

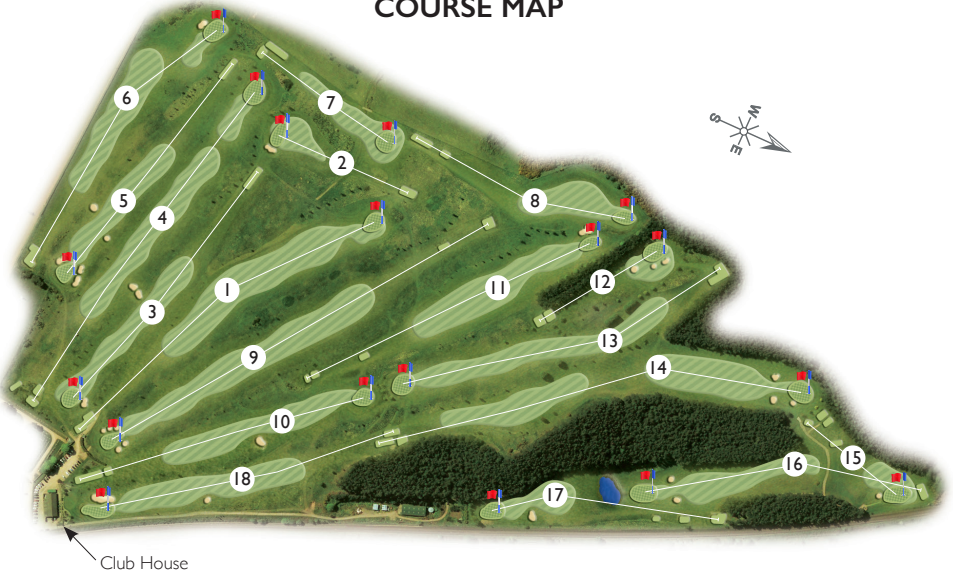
The Railway tracks are out of bounds.
