Wemyss Spirits - Sponsored Hole-in-One

Rules Update - Ground Under Repair (Fallen Trees/Stumps)

A fallen tree or tree stump that the Committee intends to remove, but is not in the process of being removed, is not automatically ground under repair. However, if the tree and the tree stump are in the process of being unearthed or cut up for later removal, they are "material piled for later removal" and therefore ground under repair.

For example, a tree that has fallen in the general area and is still attached to the stump is not ground under repair. However, a player could request relief from the Committee and the Committee would be justified in declaring the area covered by the fallen tree to be ground under repair.

HowDidIDo App - Score Submission Issues

Match has been made aware that some members' General Play and Competition scores submitted via the HowDidIDo (HDID) App have not been successfully forwarded to the ClubV1 handicap system or the Scottish Golf digital platform. This issue is intermittent and does not affect every score.

HDID have been informed and we are awaiting their response. Until a fix is confirmed, members are advised to use hard-copy scorecards or the Scottish Golf App (GPS only) as more reliable alternatives.

If you do use the HDID App and notice that your score has not been processed, please forward your recorded score to the appropriate Match official.

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Bag Tags

Members are reminded to ensure their bag tag is clearly displayed and shows the correct membership year sticker.

Member Guests - Important Reminder

It has come to the Committee's attention that some members have been booking tee times for guests without playing alongside them.

Members must accompany their guests during their round. Anyone found to be booking tee times for guests and not playing may face a two-week suspension from the course.

Tee Marker Positions - Important Notice



The Committee has received reports of members moving tee markers, particularly on the 5th tee. We would like to remind all members that tee markers must not be moved under any circumstances.

The markers are set at specific widths to provide multiple teeing positions and to help spread wear across the teeing area. Moving them undermines course management and creates unnecessary maintenance issues.

Members should also be aware that moving tee markers carries a two-shot penalty under the Rules of Golf.

We kindly ask all members to respect the course setup and leave tee markers exactly as they are found.

Buggy Use on the Course

There have been recent instances of erratic buggy driving. Members are asked to take extra care when operating buggies to ensure the safety of all players and to protect the course.

Course Etiquette - Jeans on the Course

Members are reminded that jeans are not permitted on the course. Please ensure appropriate golf attire is worn at all times.
